Champion, Inc.:

Superintendent Franzoi contacted Bill Verette to inquire about the rumor of Champion Inc. wanting to be annexed into the City of Iron Mountain.

Mr. Verette confirmed that the rumor is true. They have hired an attorney from Lansing to submit all of the paperwork to the Boundary Commission. He made note that they are not happy about the higher taxes, but their need for sewer and water supersedes that. It is nothing against the township. They feel the township has always been good to them.

The board discussed, in length, the most recent 425 agreement that the City of Iron Mountain had given to the township for review.

The board discussed the possibility of having Superintendent Franzoi prepare a request for proposal for legal services in relation to the draft intergovernmental 425 agreement with the City of Iron Mountain.

The township would like to continue meeting with Kingsford and Norway as well regarding intergovernmental cooperation.
