SPECIAL BOARD MEETING
2007 Operating Budget Review &
Lincoln Avenue Discussion
October 30, 2006

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Olson at 7:02 a.m.

Roll Call: Present: Trustees; Dixon, Wales & Erickson, Clerk Coron, Treasurer Cahee and Supervisor Olson.

Absent: Trustee Gaudette, excused.

Also Present: Superintendent, Perry Franzoi

Those in attendance gave pledge to the flag.

No public present for comment.

Superintendent Franzoi reviewed the following accounts:

101-441/DPW: no significant changes

101-528/Waste Collection: \$40,000 was added to the professional services. It is recommended that the township go out for bids for our garbage collection services.

101-691/Parks & Rec: Repairs & Maintenance was lowered to \$500 and Land Improvements was increased to \$9,500.

101-801/Planning Commission: Professional Services budgeted \$5,000 for ordinance update.

101-999/Transfers Out: TO-Revolving will be adjusted to \$137,028.

The 2007 WAGES AND SALARIES FOR APPOINTED AND ELECTED OFFICIALS was reviewed:

-Clerk and Treasurer will read \$36,000 yearly plus pension plan according to the employee pension schedule, health insurance and life insurance.

-Superintendent Salary to be determined once the board has done his review.

-Deputy Clerk salary: The hourly wage has been brought up to Clerical Employee Level I, which is \$14.53 per hour, totaling \$15,111.00 for 20 hours per week with Vi day holiday pay.

-Deputy Treasurer: The hourly wage has been brought up to Clerical Employee Level I, which is \$14.53 per hour, totaling \$17,378.00 for 23 hours per week with 14 day holiday pay.

-Fire Chief to remain at \$575 per month.

-Election Workers: Raise to \$8.50 per hour plus meals.

-Summer Help: The wage has been set between \$8-\$10. Guy Forstrom and Superintendent Franzoi to determine the rate of pay within that range.

Lincoln Avenue discussion: Supervisor Olson, Trustee Wales and Superintendent Franzoi met with the Dickinson County Sheriff, the Under-sheriff and Tim Hammill from the Dickinson County Road Commission to discuss the truck traffic and speeding problems we are seeing on Lincoln Ave. The first step is to have the Road Commission put out a monitor on Lincoln Avenue and Lake Street. Will be able to know the size of the vehicle, the time and the speed.
